## **WHAT TO BRING: PRIVATE WELL WATER SAMPLE**

**Run your water for 10 minutes, then collect sample in a container, be sure the container is labeled with residents name, date and time of sample. Sample should be kept cold until sample is brought to testing location.**

**Why Test for Nitrates? Nitrates are a vital nutrient for plants & Animals but it is also a common pollutant in MN ground water when there is too much of it. Most nitrate pollutants in ground water comes from plant matter, human & animal waste, leaking septic systems, fertilizers etc. High levels of nitrate could be harmful to infants and adults. Safe levels are 0 mg/L– 10 mg/L. If your instant test results show a high number, we will provide testing kits from RMB Labs to further investigate your water's nitrate levels.**
